



## NSTU Labour Action – Information for Parents & Guardians

NSTU to begin work-to-rule strike on December 5th

This morning, the Nova Scotia Teachers Union announced that it intends to begin a work-to-rule strike action on Monday, December 5<sup>th</sup> at all schools in Nova Scotia.

The NSTU has described the work-to-rule in this way: Teachers will continue to carry out their instructional duties in classrooms, but will not support any extracurricular activities like concerts, coaching teams or supervising clubs; field trips will not go ahead. The NSTU has indicated that teachers will arrive 20 minutes before school and leave 20 minutes after, as stipulated in the *Teachers Provincial Agreement*.

More details about the impact of a work-to-rule strike on CCRSB schools and students will be made available in the coming days.
